WHAT IS CLEAR ROADS?

- Clear Roads is a national research consortium focused on rigorous testing of winter maintenance materials, equipment and methods for use by highway maintenance crews.
- There are currently 35 states that are members of the Clear Roads group that recommend and select projects for the "pooled" funding available.



CLEAR ROADS PRIMARY ACTIVITIES

- > Evaluating winter maintenance materials, equipment and methods under real-world conditions.
- Developing specifications and recommendations.
- > Studying and promoting innovative techniques and technologies that will save agencies money, improve safety and increase efficiency.
- Supporting technology transfer by developing practical field guides and training curriculum to promote the results of research projects.

Additional Clear Roads Membership Benefits

- Pacific Northwest Snowfighters
- Clear Roads partners with the Pacific Northwest Snowfighters (PNS) to coordinate materials testing and standards for deicing chemicals by supporting the maintenance of their Qualified Product List (QPL). To be included in the QPL, the materials must:
 - Pass a series of tests for friction, corrosion, and chemical and toxicological properties
 - Meet environmental and health standards.
- Partnerships with AASHTO SICOP (technology and systems not currently in use), Aurora Pooled Fund (RWIS) to collaborate on research and provide valuable Networking and sharing.
- NETWORKING WITH OTHER CLEAR ROADS MEMBERS ON PRESSING TOPICS.
- CR research is also shared and published with APWA reporter, Roads and Bridges and Better Roads.

Computer-Based Training

> Clear Roads supports the efforts of the Snow and Ice Pooled Fund Cooperative Program in developing computer-based training modules that help train snowplow drivers, maintenance crews and others. This suite of CBTs, produced through AASHTO, provides comprehensive training in all aspects of winter roadway maintenance in a convenient and costeffective training medium. Eight CBT modules are currently available.




